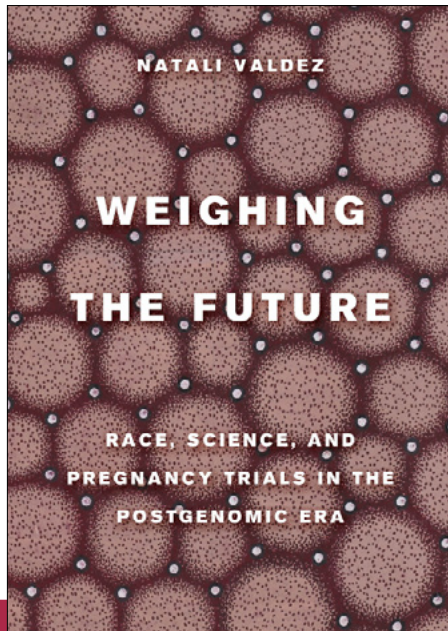


Weighing the Future
