**SUBJECT:** Five College cross-registration data for 2011-12 and recent previous years

The total number of cross-registrations for 2011-12 was up 3.6% from 2010-11, rebounding from the 4.5% decline from 2009-10 to 2010-11. At a total of 5759, the number cross-registrations for 2011-12 was the second highest total ever, only 1% below the total for 2010-11. Seven years of data is attached for both annual totals and fall and spring totals.

Taking courses off campus remains most common for students at Hampshire. Per capita undergraduate student export and import (# courses/# students) for the year (to be compared with the result for the previous year in ( ) ) and the raw export/import numbers and the difference are given below.

- Relative to 2010-11, total student export in 2011-12 declined for Smith and UMass by about 7%; it held relatively steady for Hampshire; and it increased by about 10% for Mount Holyoke and **by about 31% for Amherst** (the largest one year jump in either direction for any school in the past 7 years).
- Relative to 2010-11, total student import in 2011-12 held relatively steady for Amherst; and it increased for Hampshire, Mount Holyoke, Smith and UMass by about 23%, 6%, 2% and 5%, respectively.
- Total enrollments at the Five College Center for the Study of World Languages (at 175) were 30% below the relatively consistent levels of the previous two years.
- For Hampshire and Smith the student export numbers in Spring 2012 were similar to those for Fall 2011 (changing by -3% and +3%, respectively); **the export for Amherst was 91% higher in spring than in the fall**; for Mount Holyoke it was about 31% higher in spring than in the fall; and for UMass it was 11% higher in the spring than in the fall. In 2008-09 and 2009-10, all five campuses showed similar fall and spring export numbers except for Amherst with 27% more in spring 2011; greater spring than fall export numbers, in the range of 17%-47%, appeared for all campuses except Hampshire in 2007-08 and 2008-09.
- **The total number of cross registrations for Spring 2012 was a record for spring semesters**; at 3102 it was nearly 3% higher than the second highest spring total, in Spring 2010. Perhaps partially influencing this result, the scheduled starts on the five campuses for spring classes were only 3 days apart, the smallest gap since Spring 2009 when the gap was also 3 days (gaps in the intervening years were 8 days in Spring 2010 and Spring 2011).
- The total number of cross registrations for Fall 2011 was the third highest total of those for fall semesters; at 2657 it was about 3% below the total for Fall 2010 and 7% below the total for Fall 2009.

Large Increase in Cross-Registration for Amherst in 2011-2012, especially in Spring 2012.  
Preliminary report, September 19, 2012

We have just issued a summary report on student cross-registration for last year. Nearly 6000 courses were taken away from home. The most dramatic shift from recent years was a 30% increase in cross registrations by Amherst College students and a 23% increase in the number of course registrations at Hampshire from the other four campuses. For details, see the separate report dated September 17, 2012.

The surge in Amherst exports of enrollments is attributed by Amherst staff members to a higher than usual number of sabbaticals and unusually high demand for particular off-campus courses. Checking the courses off-campus with double-digit enrollments of Amherst students as of mid-semester reports from the Registrars to our office gave us the following surges and declines for Spring 2012 compared with Spring 2011.

Upward surges

to Smith – Sports Economy with 60 out of 77 (vs. 23 out of 56 the previous spring)

to Smith – Financial Accounting with 36 out of 84 (vs. 12 out of 71 the previous spring – perhaps because of a drop from 28 last year to 1 this year in the Financial Accounting course at Mount Holyoke which was capped at 49 students by a new professor less willing to teach the larger sections welcomed by the teacher in preceding years; 48 of the 49 students in this course in Spring 2012 were from Mount Holyoke)

to Hampshire – Sustainable Agriculture/Organic Farming with 18 out of 53 (not offered previously)

to University – My DNA with 14 out of 237 (vs. 1 out of 271 the previous spring)

to University – World Politics with 11 out of 323 (vs. 3 out of 261 the previous spring).

Large declines

to Mount Holyoke – Financial Accounting with 1 out of 49 (vs. 12 out of 71 the previous spring; course enrollment for Spring 2012 was capped at 49 students by a new professor less willing to teach the larger sections welcomed by the teacher in preceding years)

to University – Intro to Accounting with 10 of 473 (vs. 20 of 414 the previous spring)

These major shifts (up and down) in mid-semester registrations account for 47 of the increase of 179 course registrations off campus by Amherst students from Spring 2011 to Spring 2012.

Further Analysis is Possible
